SCHEDULE**PART B: MINIMUM WAGES**

1. **Substitute clause 2** as reflected in the Government Gazette No.36224 dated 8 March 2013 with the following:

2. **MINIMUM WAGES**

1) With effect from 01 April 2015, an employer must pay a forestry worker at least the minimum wage prescribed in terms of table 1.
