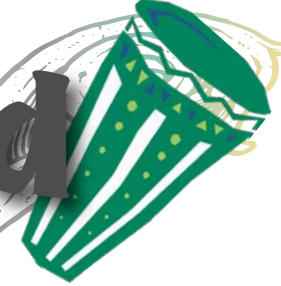

What is the Youth-to-Youth Fund?

The Youth-to-Youth Fund was created as a mechanism to identify, test and promote innovative entrepreneurship solutions to youth employment challenges. The Youth-to-Youth Fund involves youth in developing entrepreneurship in their communities by supporting small-scale development projects by youth-led organizations.

What kind of proposals?

The Fund welcomes project ideas from non-profit organizations that contribute to the development of entrepreneurship and business opportunities for young women. Interested organizations should facilitate the process of young women becoming entrepreneurs or support their current entrepreneurship activities. Proposals should focus on ways to empower and enable young women to establish and improve their enterprises.

Who can apply?

Applications must be from officially registered non-governmental, non-partisan, not-for-profit youth-led organizations. Project managers for the proposed projects must be a young person under the age of 30.

What are youth-led organizations?

The Youth-to-Youth Fund defines “youth-led organizations” as formally registered membership organizations, such as non-governmental organizations (NGOs), community-based organizations (CBOs), associations, networks, platforms, business membership organizations (BMOs) young entrepreneurs’ associations, forums, cooperatives, coalitions in which young people between the ages of 18 and 35 represent the majority of the management and the decision making body.

Preferred applicants

Proposals by the following types of applicants are encouraged:

- Proposals from the following YEF target districts: Bagamoyo, Handeni, Lindi Urban, Micheweni, Mtwara Rural, Mpanda, Musoma Urban, Rufiji, Singida Urban, Tabora, Unguja North A, and Urambo
- Projects that will be managed by a young woman
- Proposals submitted in partnerships with other actors such as government agencies, other CSOs, banks, microfinance institutions, etc., rather than by one organization alone
