



Memorandum of Understanding

between

The World Bank

and

The International Labour Organization

WHEREAS the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Development Association (collectively, "World Bank") and the International Labour Organization, represented by the International Labour Office ("the ILO"), (collectively, the "Parties") recognize the critical importance of partnerships for meeting the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development;

WHEREAS the Parties share a common intention to foster cooperation and acknowledge the need to define an enabling environment in pursuit of this endeavour, in particular the promotion of decent work for all women and men;

NOW THEREFORE the Parties agree that when a Government engages the ILO in provision of Technical Assistance or for the Delivery of Outputs, related to its mandate utilizing World Bank financing, the annexed Standard Forms of Agreements shall be used and should not be amended except by agreement in writing of the World Bank and the ILO.

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed in two copies in Geneva, Switzerland on 17 November 2016 and is valid for an indefinite period and may be terminated by either Party upon six (6) months' written notice to the other Party.
