- Provided Skills Trainings to cooperative farmers, vendors, housewives, would-be entrepreneurs in order to maximize their talents, skills and resources thereby avoiding wastage of products
- Taught value-adding products out of the raw materials that they have in order to earn a bigger income and expand their existing market i.e. unsold vegetable products processed into juices and crackers; unsold fish processed into sardines and other fish dishes

- Conducted Skills Training on Fish Processing to diversify the products of the fish vendors who currently lives on selling raw fish and other marine products
- Conducted Skills Training on Vegetable Processing to Farmers' cooperative to boost their sales on vegetables and avoid wastage of resources



Conducted Skills Training on Enhancement on Sewing to the Dressmakers group to expand their sewn products and increase their production







- □ Continuous/year-round technical assistance and guidance given to these groups to ensure the sustainability of their operation
- □ Provided Livelihood Financial Assistance as a start-up capital (new entrepreneurs) or to augment the existing capital (those who are already into business)

We have the whole year-round Rice **Enhancement Program, High Value** Crop Development Program, Farm and Home Management Program to ensure that these sectors are also given priority.

Distributed 1,300 bags of Palay seeds and fertilizers to the farmers in the different barangays of the City

...for the Farmers and Fisherfolks

- Conducted Skills Trainings on Rice and Vegetable Production, and in the maintenance of the farm machineries to farmers of 13 rice producing barangays and 12 vegetable producing barangays
- Provided farm machineries and equipment i.e. 4WD tractor, combine-harvester, rice thresher, floating tiller, and many others
- Distributed assorted vegetable seeds
