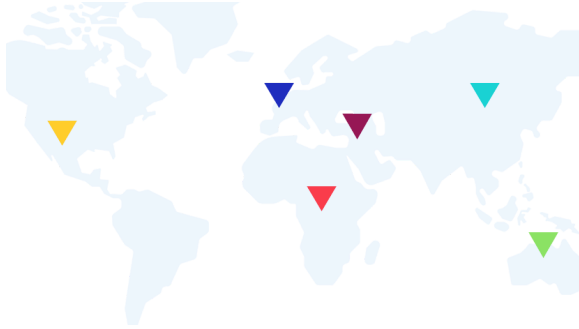

Geographical distribution of participants of online courses and self-guided online courses

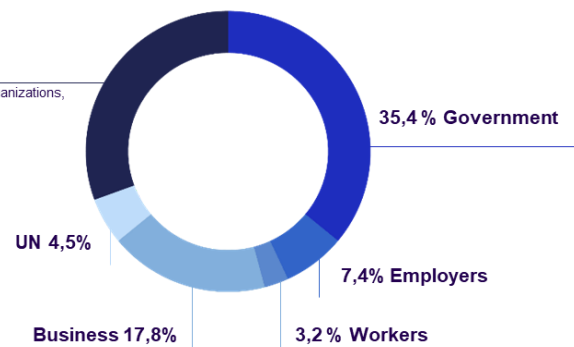


1761 Participants in online and F2F courses (2022)

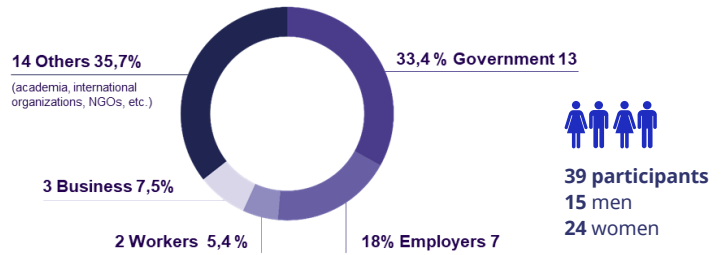

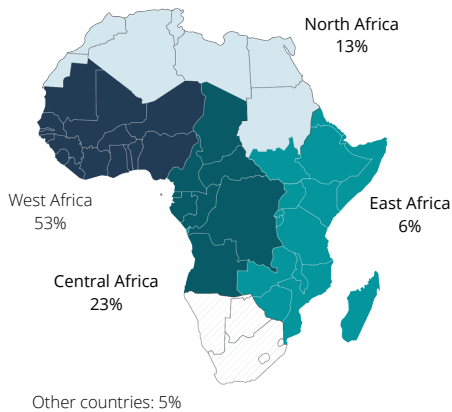

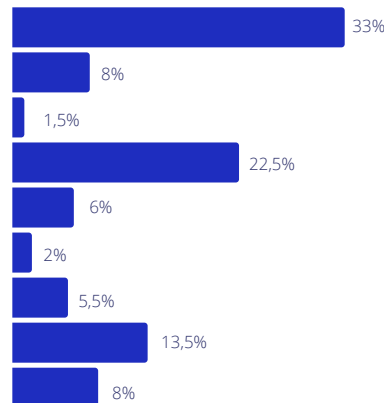
