## Report of the Director-General

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## I. Progress in international labour legislation

### Ratifications of Conventions and Protocols to Conventions

1. Since the preparation of the document submitted to the 303rd Session of the Governing Body, the Director-General has registered the following ten ratifications of international labour Conventions, bringing the total number registered on 30 January 2009 to 7,606. **II. Internal administration**

3. Article 4.2(d) of the Staff Regulations states:

Vacancies in the Director and Principal Officer category shall be filled by the Director-General by transfer in the same grade, promotion or appointment. Such promotions or appointments, other than to vacancies in technical cooperation projects, shall be reported to the Governing Body with a short statement of the qualifications of the persons so promoted or appointed.

4. The following appointments and promotions are accordingly reported to the Governing Body:

**Ms Judica Amri-Makhetha (United Republic of Tanzania)**

Appointed Senior Adviser, External Relations and Partnerships in the ILO Regional Office for Africa in Addis Ababa, with effect from 1 February 2009. Promotion to D.1 was reported to the Governing Body in March 2005.

**Ms Loretta de Luca (Italy)**

Appointed Senior Adviser for Employment, Employment Sector, with effect from 1 February 2009. Promotion to D.1 was reported to the Governing Body in November 2005.

**Mr Mark Levin (Israel)**

Appointed Director of the ILO Subregional Office for Central and Eastern Europe in Budapest, with effect from 1 December 2008. Promotion to D.1 was reported to the Governing Body in March 2006.

**Mr Juan Llobera Serra (Spain)**

Appointed Chief of the Human Resources Policies and Development Branch (HR/POL), Human Resources Development Department, Management and Administration Sector, and promoted to D.1 with effect from 1 March 2009.

Mr Llobera Serra has a law degree from the Universidad Autónoma of Madrid, and a master's degree in international administration from the Université de Paris II. He is a member of the Madrid Bar.

He joined the ILO as a junior legal officer in 1991 and worked in various capacities in the Office of the Legal Adviser until 2004, when he was appointed as Senior Adviser to the ILO Executive Director for Management and Administration. Between June 2006 and February 2009, Mr Llobera was on secondment to the World Meteorological Organization, where he held the position of Legal Counsel.

Throughout his career Mr Llobera has worked on issues related to human resource policy development and dispute settlement. Mr Llobera was a member of the ILO Joint Negotiating Committee.

**Mr Mohamed Ali Ould Sidi Mohamed (Mauritania)**

Appointed Senior Adviser for Africa and the Arab States, Director-General's Office (CABINET), with effect from 1 January 2009. Promotion to D.1 was reported to the Governing Body in November 2003.

**Mr Yousef Qaryouti (Jordan)**

Appointed Director of the ILO Subregional Office for North Africa in Cairo, and promoted to D.1 with effect from 1 February 2009.

Born in 1952. Mr Qaryouti holds a doctorate degree in special education and rehabilitation with a minor in political sociology from Michigan State University (United States).

Since joining the ILO in 1994, Mr Qaryouti has served in the Multidisciplinary Team for the Arab States. He also served as an Officer-in-Charge for the Regional Office for the Arab States for the period April 2006–March 2007, during which the war erupted in the region. He successfully carried out the evacuation, relocation and then the return of the Office to Beirut, Lebanon. He headed the ILO Emergency Tasks Force Teams and emergency missions for Iraq (2003) and Lebanon (2006). He has designed and delivered numerous technical cooperation projects and training programmes, particularly in the fields of rehabilitation, post-crisis rehabilitation and reconstruction, and community

development. He has represented the ILO in various high-level UN coordination meetings and donor's conferences.

Prior to joining the ILO, Mr Qaryouti held several teaching positions at different Arab universities from 1984 to 1992, worked with UNDP (1993), UNRWA (1977) and the Michigan State University (1981–84).

Mr Qaryouti is the author and co-author of several books and research articles and has served on the boards of several international NGOs.

#### **Mr Vic van Vuuren (South Africa)**

Appointed Director of the ILO Office for South Africa, Botswana, Lesotho, Namibia and Swaziland in Pretoria, at the D.1 level with effect from 1 February 2009.

Born in 1957. Mr van Vuuren holds a Bachelor of Law (B Juris) from the University of South Africa (UNISA) and also completed an advanced executive programme at the University of South Africa School of Business Leadership.

After completing his law degree, Mr van Vuuren started his working career at the South African Department of Justice as a public prosecutor and magistrate. Thereafter he moved to the national transport company, Transnet Ltd, where he initially functioned as a legal advisor but eventually occupied the position of General Manager, Human Resources. In January 1997, he moved from Transnet and took up the position of Chief Executive: Human Resources at a South African financial services company, Sanlam, a position he occupied until December 2005.

In 2006, Mr van Vuuren was appointed Chief Operations Officer in the newly formed employer federation, Business Unity South Africa (BUSA). Mr van Vuuren has represented employers at the National Economic, Development and Labour Council (NEDLAC) and served on the NEDLAC Executive and Management Committees. He also served on the BUSA Governing Body, BUSA Management Committee and acted as business advisor to the Millennium Labour Council (a national bipartite employer and worker council).

Furthermore, he has, until his appointment to the ILO Office Pretoria, served on the South African Council for Higher Education and also represented organized business on the Joint Initiative on Priority Skills Acquisition (JIPSA). Mr van Vuuren has represented employers at the ILO over the past 11 years and has been a member of the ILO Governing Body from 2005 where he served, inter alia, on the ILO Committee on Freedom of Association as Employer lead spokesperson. He has also served on the Council of the Pan African Employers' Confederation and has been South Africa's lead delegate for organized business at the International Labour Organization since 2005.
