# Appointments to the ILO Staff Pension Committee (United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board)

- 1. In accordance with article 6(c) of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, three members and three alternate members are appointed to the ILO Staff Pension Committee (United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board) by the International Labour Conference on the recommendation of the Governing Body. The Governing Body decided at its 253rd Session (May–June 1992) that appointments to the Staff Pension Committee should reflect tripartite representation.
- **2.** The appointments for the period 9 October 2010 to 8 October 2013 are placed before the current session of the Governing Body for recommendation to the 99th Session (June 2010) of the International Labour Conference.
- **3.** The three-year terms of the following Staff Pension Committee members and alternate members appointed by the Conference expire on 8 October 2010:

Members

Mr D. Willers (Germany)

Mr M. Barde (Employers)

Mr M. Blondel (Workers)

Alternate members

Mr T. Montant (Switzerland)

**4.** The Government group has recommended the extension of the appointment of Mr Willers and Mr Montant for a further term. They have both served since 2004, and are willing to continue to serve. Mr Willers is a former member of the Governing Body of the ILO and Mr Montant is a pension specialist who is head of a public pension plan in Geneva.

- **5.** Concerning the Employers' members, the group has proposed the name of Mr Jean-Paul Bernard (Switzerland) to replace Mr Barde, who indicated that he will not be able to continue for a further term. Mr Bernard is the Deputy Director-General of the "Fédération des enterprises romandes" (FER–GE) and former Director of the Provident Fund of that Federation (Caisse interentreprises de prévoyance professionnelle de la FER).
- **6.** The Workers' group proposes the extension of Mr Blondel for a further term. Mr Blondel is a former member of the Governing Body of the ILO and a member of the Pension Committee since 1998. He has confirmed his availability to continue serving in the Committee.
- 7. The Committee may accordingly wish to recommend to the Governing Body that it submit the following resolution to the Conference at its 99th Session (June 2010):
