Composition and agenda of standing bodies and meetings

Tripartite Meeting of Experts on Labour Statistics on the Advancement of Employment and Unemployment Statistics (Geneva, 28 January–1 February 2013)

Composition

1. A reserve list for government nominations has been established and approved by the Governing Body¹ which includes the Governments of the following countries: Colombia, Mauritius, Norway, Turkey and Spain. The Director-General proposes that Australia be added to the reserve list for the Meeting in order to reflect a greater regional balance.
2. *The Officers of the Governing Body recommend that the Governing Body approve that Australia be added to the reserve list for government nominations.*
