

Report of the Committee of Experts on the Application of Conventions and Recommendations

(Geneva, 27 November-14 December 2013)

- 1. The Committee of Experts on the Application of Conventions and Recommendations held its 84th Session in Geneva from 27 November to 14 December 2013. It adopted a report which, in accordance with the usual practice, has been printed as a Conference document and is submitted to the Governing Body at its present session. As in previous years, the report has been published in two volumes for the sake of convenience.
- 2. Under its terms of reference, the Committee was called upon to examine:
 - (a) reports from governments on the application of Conventions that they have ratified (articles 22 and 35 of the Constitution);
 - (b) information supplied by governments on the submission of certain Conventions, Recommendations and Protocols to the competent authorities (article 19 of the Constitution); and
 - (c) reports from governments on the Minimum Wage Fixing Convention, 1970 (No. 131), and Recommendation, 1970 (No. 135), as decided by the Governing Body (article 19 of the Constitution).
- **3.** In particular, the Governing Body's attention is drawn to the Committee's General Survey entitled "Minimum wage systems". This General Survey will be found in Volume B of the Committee's report. It is based on reports supplied under articles 19 and 22 of the ILO Constitution.
- **4.** The Governing Body is invited to take note of the report of the Committee of Experts on the Application of Conventions and Recommendations.
