






Out of a stock of **11.11 million** Pakistani migrant workers, women account for only **0.4 percent**.


Labour migration trends from Pakistan (2009-2019)



Patterns of international labour migration by regions of Pakistan




Top five destination countries of Pakistani migrant workers

Outflow of Pakistani migrant workers by method of recruitment





Key occupational trades recruited for overseas work




Other occupational trades account for 20.3%


Remittances sent to Pakistan by key destination countries
